Legionella is a life-threatening waterborne bacterium transmitted by inhalation of contaminated water droplets. These can be present in most environments where there is both natural and man-made water systems.

Cold Water Storage Tanks

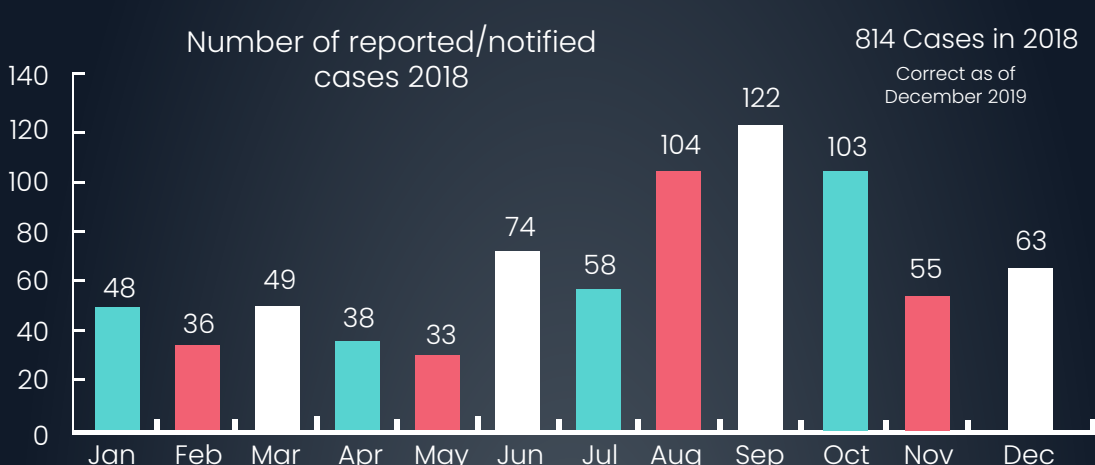
Taps, Pipework and Calorifiers

Cooling Towers & Evaporative Condensers

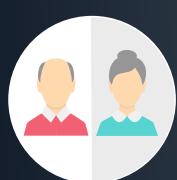

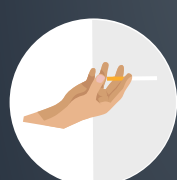


WHO IS AT RISK?

Smokers



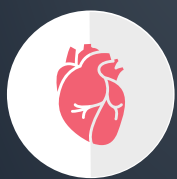
